DENTAL TARTAR

What is the issue?

This animal has some dental tartar and mild gingivitis found on routine examination, and could benefit from a thorough oral health assessment and dental cleaning under general anesthesia.

What has OHS done so far?

A veterinary technician or a veterinarian has done a thorough oral examination on this animal.

What still needs to be done?

A dental procedure (general anesthesia, full oral health assessment, scale/polish and extractions if indicated) will likely need to be performed within the next year.

What can the adopter expect?

There should not be any current discomfort in the mouth associated with this degree of dental disease.
